"The Grinner on the Wardrobe Door" - by Sandy Murphy - story


- [1] [AF2] Who owns the "Healthiest Pet"? [1 mk]

"Power Cut" - by Jane Buxton - story

- [4] [AF3] What was Abigail doing when the power went out? [1 mk]
[5] [AF3] Explain why Jessica thought it would be "cool" to have some chestnuts. [1 mk]
[6] [AF3] Explain why there was a second power cut? Be sure to mention the "purpose" of the second power cut. [2 mks]
[7] [AF5] Give two words from page 11 which indicate fear. [1 mks]
[8] [AF5] Which words/phrases on page 16 indicate Grandpa and Grandma agreed to work together? Explain how they were going to work together. [2 mks]
[9] [AF6] How does the author help the reader understand why Abigail wishes there was no electricity? Include your understanding about why Abigail doesn't want electricity. [2 mks]
[10] [AF7] One reflection about this story might be that the representation of the grandparents is very "stereotypical/cliched". Explain how this is true. [2 mks]

[23] [\[AF6\]](#) Based on the way the author has portrayed them, give two adjectives to describe the character of the birds, and two adjectives to describe the character of the tortoise. [2 mks] [\[Help\]](#)

[24] [\[AF7\]](#) Folk tales with animals as the main characters often include a "trickster". Often, the "trickster" gets outwitted or has the tables turned, and a trick is played on them! Explain the trick the tortoise plays, and then explain how the parrot gains revenge. [2 mks]

[25] [\[AF3\]](#) Imagine you were one of the birds at the feast and Tortoise is eating all the good food and drink. Write a short opinion piece on your feelings about Tortoise and the whole situation. [2 mks]
